# Muffin Party

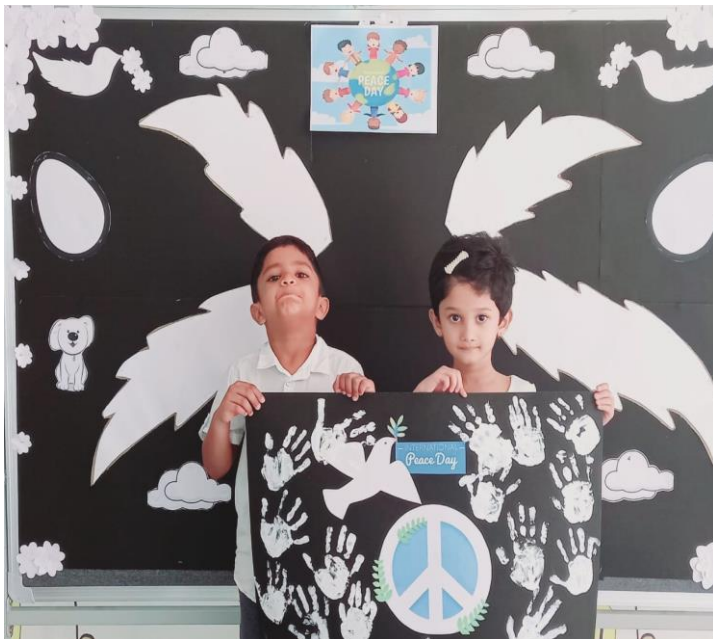


A day for 'muffin Party 'was arranged for the students of grade-2. Parents played an active role in sharing delicious recipes and sending them with the children.
